Very pleasing numbers forward at the opening sale of store lambs for the 2013 season and trade very much the same as anticipated. Monthly prime lamb show well supported

A large entry of above 150 lambs forward at the first of the monthly prime lamb shows, kindly sponsored by JG Animal Health, gave judge Mr Tom Turner of Turners Butchers, Darwen market a difficult task. The winner of the best pen of 5 Texel or Continental lambs was David Whalley of J Whalley & Sons, Darwen who had a super pen of 38.5kg Texel cross lambs. These later went on to sell to judge Mr Turner at £74 a head (192ppkg).

Overall prices were similar to the previous week, with good tight skinned, optimum weight lambs in demand, best lambs topping at just short of £2/kg. Auctioneer Joe Worthington commented, "The majority of lambs forward were creep fed and well finished, and prices were in keeping with the national average. Unfortunately this has declined over recent weeks but I feel confident prices will lift in the near future."
