Under the hammer at Silverwoods antiques sales . . .

Silverwoods' Wednesday Rediscovery sales of antiques, collectables and household furniture have been so busy – with between 400 and 600 lots coming under the hammer every week – that the sale now starts at 1.00 pm.

The bi-monthly Special Sales take place in the main saleroom at Lincoln Way. The next scheduled sale, which is live online via www.thesaleroom.com, takes place on **Thursday 28th February** and among some high quality items on offer are first edition books, rare musical instruments and beautiful jewellery, gold and silver and oils and watercolours.

If you haven't bought or sold at an auction before, Silverwoods has produced some simple guidance for people who would like to give it a go. Bring ceramics, pictures, silver, jewellery, furniture, collectables and antiques to Silverwoods any Monday between 9 am and 3.00 pm when one of the company's expert team of valuers will appraise it. The items will be valued and, where necessary, specialist research carried out into their provenance.

These Monday valuations are free and with no-obligation, you will also be advised which of the two different Silverwoods sales your goods will be most suitable for and you can then decide whether or not to sell them. If you do decide to sell, they will be fully receipted and simply leave them at the saleroom. There is sellers' commission to deduct – at Silverwoods this is normally £15% plus VAT. If you have a large number of items to sell or they are too heavy to bring along, you can contact the saleroom to arrange a home visit from a valuer. Then come along to the auctions to see your items being sold or just wait for a cheque which will be posted to you. If you do come along to the friendly sales and think you might be tempted to buy, you will need to call into the office before the sale starts to register and get a 'bidders' number' which you then use to bid for the items you want. The advice from the sales staff is to fix in your own mind the maximum you want to spend, remember that there is also a buyers' premium on top of the hammer price and don't get too carried away! Clitheroe premier for poultry

The next catalogue sale of pure bred poultry & waterfowl will be held on **Saturday 9th February at 10am** and the sale already looks very promising with all cages available already pre booked! Nearly 500 cages of birds are forward and the complete listing of breeds forward are in the catalogue available on the website www.auctionmart.co.uk or upon request from the office. With no buyers premium at this sale purchasers are able to take advantage of the high quality birds on offer with many providing a good basis for breeding stock.

In addition to this special bi monthly sale, Clitheroe holds regular poultry sales, every Wednesday evening from 5.30pm.

Stock for these sales are simply entered from 10am on the morning of the sale up to 5.00pm (or when there is no longer cage availability) so no catalogue listing is available for these sales. Typically there will be approx 300 cages of poultry, waterfowl, rabbits, pigeons, ferrets, geese and plus many lots of associated accessories forward.

This sale also runs in conjunction with the popular cage & aviary bird sale which is held every Wednesday from 6.00pm and includes a fantastic selection of parrots, canaries, budgies, cockatiels, lovebirds, rodents, arachnids and testudines forward each week. Rural Bygones the business!

After a tricky snowy start to the day a very encouraging crowd turned out to attend our first Bygones foray of 2013. As ever the sale got off to a flying start with most lots being eagerly competed for by some very determined bidders. All manner of items drew strong bids including small cast piglet troughs at £32; A cast iron cauldron £35; a greenhouse mans' breast plough made £32 and a hand push seed drill £35. Vintage joiners' planes sold up to £60; butchers cleavers up to £35 and a shallow wooden wheelbarrow at £65. A sword stick made £110; Mixed lots of hunting crops sold well at £50 and £60 each.

As the sale settled into its stride and with plenty encouragement from Wilf the level of bidding remained high especially for the more interesting and unusual items such as dolly tubs up to £32; leg vices making £30; a 1940's glass sweet dispenser £55; gate notices up to £60 a garden flame thrower £40; Sandstone grinding wheel £75 and a model bow top caravan which made £130.

All manner of reproduction cast iron signs

were on offer and made strong prices as the originals are now so hard to come by and so expensive when they do crop up. A shotgun cartridge magazine sold for £80 and a pair of faux Stag Antlers reached £70; a stuffed full fox made £80 and a mounted Badger fore quarter £100.

Vintage Kitchen and Needlework items are always popular with a cotton reel cabinet fetching £35; an adjustable cardboard mannequin £52 and a selection of coat hangers reached £35; a small meat safe £20; a small kitchen cabinet £45; rhubarb forcers £45 and £65 each; butter bowls up to £38. Horse brasses were popular with mixed lots fetching up to £60. Tilley and other type oil lamps have a strong following with boxes of spares making up to £58.

As usual the sale was a great success helped by its appeal to interior decorators and the next one, scheduled for Saturday 23rd March is already well on its way to being fully subscribed. If you have any items suitable for this sale it would be advisable to have them entered as quickly as possible.
