Only registered sheep will be eligible for the show and **ALL SHEEP** must have been registered in accordance with the Society's regulations prior to the show and sale. All sheep entered for the sale will have been inspected for breed standards by the Society's registrars prior to the sale and any sheep rejected will not be allowed to enter the sale. All entries must be included in the catalogue and late entries will be refused.
