It was great to see the sale ring packed with no room to sit or stand, there was a great buzz around the market. Strong cattle were a tremendous trade, with young cattle every bit as dear. 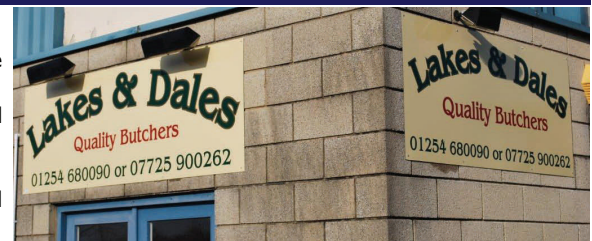
Butchers shop under new ownership

The sale currently has entered approx 30 families of continental cows with calves at foot plus a good selection of Limousin & BB bulling heifers.

Wyandottes & Wheaten Marans in demand . . .

A fantastic turnout of customers, travelling from as far as Lanarkshire, South Wales and Devon, were in attendance at the first catalogue sale of pure bred poultry and waterfowl at Clitheroe for 2013.

Following the success of last years combined sale with the Longridge & District Fanciers Annual show, again the day was a massive success and the packed out auction area brought a real buzz to the place. With just over 500 lots in the poultry section and close to 100 in the deadstock (with lots including huts, incubators and hatching eggs) it was an exceptionally busy day all round.

Trade for all stock was superb, but especially for large soft feather varieties such as Welsummers and Light Sussex with the average price for pullets being between £20 to £25 a head across the board.

Top price on the day was for a pair of Wheaten Marans from well known poultry breeder Mrs M I Bowman of Harrogate, selling for a magnificent £140 to Mr A Lawton of Durham. Also selling for the same astounding price was a trio of White Wyandottes from young enthusiast, six year old, Miss Elizabeth Tarbatt of Darwen (pictured top right). These amazing birds went on to sell to Mr M Chapman and had a long trip to their new home in Llangefni, Anglesey.

In addition, the soft feather bantams were also a hit with many families on a day out



looking for a few chickens for their gardens or small holdings. A quartet of White Silkies sold for £110 to Mr Ian Bates from Congleton, Cheshire with 2 Blue Silkie pullets selling at £75 to the same purchaser. Call Ducks dominated in the waterfowl section with pairs selling to £50 and there were some excellent specimens of Chocolate Muscovys on sale which created a lot of attention amongst potential purchasers. Auctioneer Jeremy Greenhalgh said **"Today was an excellent sale, as spring approaches good soft feather large fowl was very much in demand realising some very good prices, many more could have been sold."**

The next bi-monthly catalogue sale will be on **Saturday 6th April** which is already attracting a lot of interest with entry forms now available from the website or main office. (Entries close Wed 20th March)

Apothecary collection good medicine at Silverwoods

A collection of specialist apothecary antiques, including pill making machines, ointment pots, inhalers, mortars, measuring glasses, medicine and storage bottles (pictured) went under the hammer for more than £2,400 at Silverwoods' Antiques and Fine Art sale on 28th February. The most popular items were two brass and turned barbers bowls (pictured)— one dating to the 18th century – which trebled their estimate and sold for £620.

Among another collection in the auction – this time of top quality camera equipment - three unusual Leica (M6 and M2 models—one pictured) went for more than £3,000. Earlier in the sale, a Shelley Queen Anne 21 piece floral pattern teaset was sold to a commission bidder for £380 – more than six times its estimate – and a pair of Staffordshire figures 'The Welsh

Tailor and His Wife', each astride a goat, was knocked down to a telephone bidder for £320, despite being damaged.

Gold and silver items continued to sell well in the room with a large silver rosebowl going for £1,200, a 9ct gold Art Deco square compact for £720, a masonic gold pendant for £300 and an unusual mid 20th century gold whistle selling for £190.

In the picture section, a pair of engravings by Thomas Landseer after Sir Edwin Landseer featuring stags in a moorland setting, signed by the engraver (originally purchased at the sale of the collection of Rosa Bonheur) sold for £680.

The value of well-regarded local artist Stella Platt's works continues to rise and a signed painting by her of Peel Brow, Ramsbottom, was bought by an internet bidder for £180.

In the furnishings and interior décor category at the end of the sale, the highlights proved to be a good quality reproduction George III style mahogany bookcase sideboard which doubled its estimate, reaching £700, and a local dealer purchased a Chinese screen with birds and foliage in carved abalone, hardstone, ivory and various woods, again raising £700.
